### **Workshop synopsis:**

UN/CEFACT's Modeling Methodology (UMM) is a UML-based approach for capturing the business processes between organizations. UMM guides a business analyst from requirements elicitation to the design phase of an inter-organizational system. UMM is independent to the technology used to exchange the business documents. The workshop will introduce the new features of UMM 2.0 – which is currently in Implementation Verification.

During the workshop participants will learn the basic principles of UN/CEFACT's Modeling Methodology and examine its different features. A hands-on-tutorial session will give the participants the opportunity to create their own UMM model under the instructors' supervision.
